Rights of EEA EFTA States

EEA Agreement – Art. 81

Guarantees that the rights and obligations of participants from the EFTA States in the Programme or action in question shall be the same as those of participants from the EU States.

How Much?

Original Estimates in put the EEA EFTA commitment to the 2014-2020 MFF is approximately **EUR 3.22 billion**

For comparison, the estimate made in 2006 to the previous MFF 2007-2013 was **EUR 1.7 billion**

May 2018 - Norway exceeds two per cent share of Horizon 2020 contribution for the first time. (5.4 billion NOK)







Financial Impact on EEA EFTA Contribution

- Decrease in focus on Cohesion and the CAP - Outside of the scope of EEA EFTA Participation
- Increase in commitments towards Internal Market initiatives and Programmes - areas where EEA EFTA Participates
- => Absolute Increase in EEA Contribution



Financial Impact on EEA EFTA Contribution

- UK's departure Currently carries around 15% of the EU28 GDP
- Recalculating the 2019 proportionality factor on the basis of the EU27 GDP -EEA EFTA contribution = 2.83% (2.42% EU28)
- => Relative Increase in EEA Contribution.



EEA EFTA Contribution Erasmus 2021-2027

• Erasmus+ 2014-2020_(current prices) = 365m euro

Erasmus 2021-2027 = 849m euro

Increase = 133%



EEA EFTA Contribution Horizon Europe 2021-2027

Horizon 2014-2020_(current prices) = 1 901m euro

Horizon 2021-2027 (current prices) = 2 762m euro

• Increase = 45.3%




Steps for inclusion of new Programmes

- The Secretariat will inform the relevant Working Groups continuously on MFF and Programmes
- The Secretariat will follow and seek to influence developments on the EU side and provide the Working Groups with estimated dates for adoption

- EEA to Inform EU of Participation by February 2020
 - Indicative
 - Non-binding
- EEA to include Programme regulations by February 2021
 - Important to ensure full participation from beginning 2021
