

EUSBSR: key facts


- first EU macro-regional strategy (in 2009)
- 8 EU Member States; cooperation with Belarus, Iceland, Norway, Russia
- based on long history of cooperation
- common challenges/opportunities
- 3 objectives (Save the Sea, Connect the Region, Increase Prosperity)
- 17 thematic areas (incl. 'Culture')








Opportunities to connect to the EUSBSR
