The Scandria®Alliance is a partnership of regions in the Scandria®Corridor, from the Nordic countries along the Scandinavian–Mediterranean Core Network Corridor. The members share a vision of a "green corridor" connecting the innovative Scandinavian regions with the economically vibrant North Italian regions via the Capital Region Berlin-Brandenburg, aiming to become a European and world-wide front-runner in future mobility and regional development.

The webinar is organized by the Work Group on Clean Fuels, which is one of three Work Groups in the alliance. Partners from Berlin-Brandenburg, Region Örebro County, Region Skåne, City of Turku, Helsinki-Uusimaa Region and Eastern Norway County Network collaborate to foster the transition to alternative fuels for transport of goods and people in the corridor.

The examples presented will reflect on the transnational dimension and relevance of approaches followed in the regions. This may be the very first step towards transnational cooperation on deployment of clean fuels.
