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Interreg er EUs programsamarbeid for grenseregionalt, transnasjonalt og inter-regionalt samarbeid i Europa. Gjennom samarbeid løfte hele Europa økonomisk, sosialt og miljømessig (ikke del av EØS-avtalen)

- 11 land - 8 EU land (Danmark, Estland, Finland, Latvia, Litauen, Polen, Sverige og Tyskland) + **Norge, Russland og (Belarus)**
- Fokus grønn transformasjon – klima og digitalisering er tverrgående tema
- Stort fokus på forenkling

Mer brukervennlige offentlige tjenester

Actions that improve organisational set-ups and processes to respond to public needs - deliver less bureaucratic and more cost-efficient public services

Build capacity of public authorities, specialised agencies, service providers to innovate and invent new solutions that are more responsive to change.

Develop systematic public responses - cross sectors and borders - benchmark solutions across countries to create incentives to improve the quality of their delivery.

Enhancing social innovation and empower citizens through new technologies

Support resource-efficient and environmentally-friendly public offer for citizens - creating opportunities for businesses through innovative partnerships



Bærekraftig vannforvaltning

The Programme supports actions that improve the state of water in the region and make its management more sustainable. These waters include the Baltic Sea, coastal waters and inland waters like rivers, lakes and groundwater.



Blå vekst/maritim økonomi

The Programme supports actions on sustainable use of fresh and sea waters as well as marine resources in innovative business development in the whole region in emerging and established sectors. These include aquaculture, blue biotechnology, shipping, fishery, and coastal and maritime tourism



Sirkulær økonomi

The Programme supports actions that facilitate the shift from linear to circular resource use. This implies keeping products and materials in use for as long as possible without increasing pressure on the environment. The holistic approach shall go beyond waste management to connect with water, energy, transport and land use.



Energi-omstilling

The Programme supports actions for the de-carbonisation of energy systems in the region in order to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The solutions shall increase energy efficiency in industrial production processes as well as in public and private building stock. The Programme also encourages actions to increase renewable energy production from locally available resources.



Smart og grønn mobilitet

A green and well-functioning cross-border mobility system is vital for the development of the region. The Programme supports the smooth movement of people and goods in and across urban and rural areas while saving resources by increasing efficiency, integrating different transport modes and accelerating digitalisation



Makro-regional governance

The Programme supports actions that implement and strengthen governance and communication activities in the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR). They shall facilitate policy discussions and trigger policy changes, build up networks to develop projects and other initiatives in line with the EUSBSR Action Plan.

- Programmet vil være på i underkant av 250 mill Euro (ERDF + Norge) Norges del er på 5 mill Euro (med euro-kurs på 10 kr)
- I tillegg kommer midler for Russland (og Belarus) når den finansielle avtalen med EU er på plass
- Alle landene unntatt Norge vil ha 80/20 finansiering. Norge fortsetter med 50/50
- Midlene deles likt mellom de sju temaene
- Testing og utprøving - piloter ønskes
